

Flood damage!

This winter has been wonderful for lots of water, but of course planting alongside a river in flood does result in some damage. The line in the photo indicates roughly where the river usually is when not in flood.



Our revegetation at Gari Bridge Sth. survived remarkably well, considering, with almost no losses ...





... except right along the river bank, where perhaps 30% were lost. Here's what the plants look like, down near the river's edge: no guards, and we've made sure that one stake marks where the surviving plants are growing.
